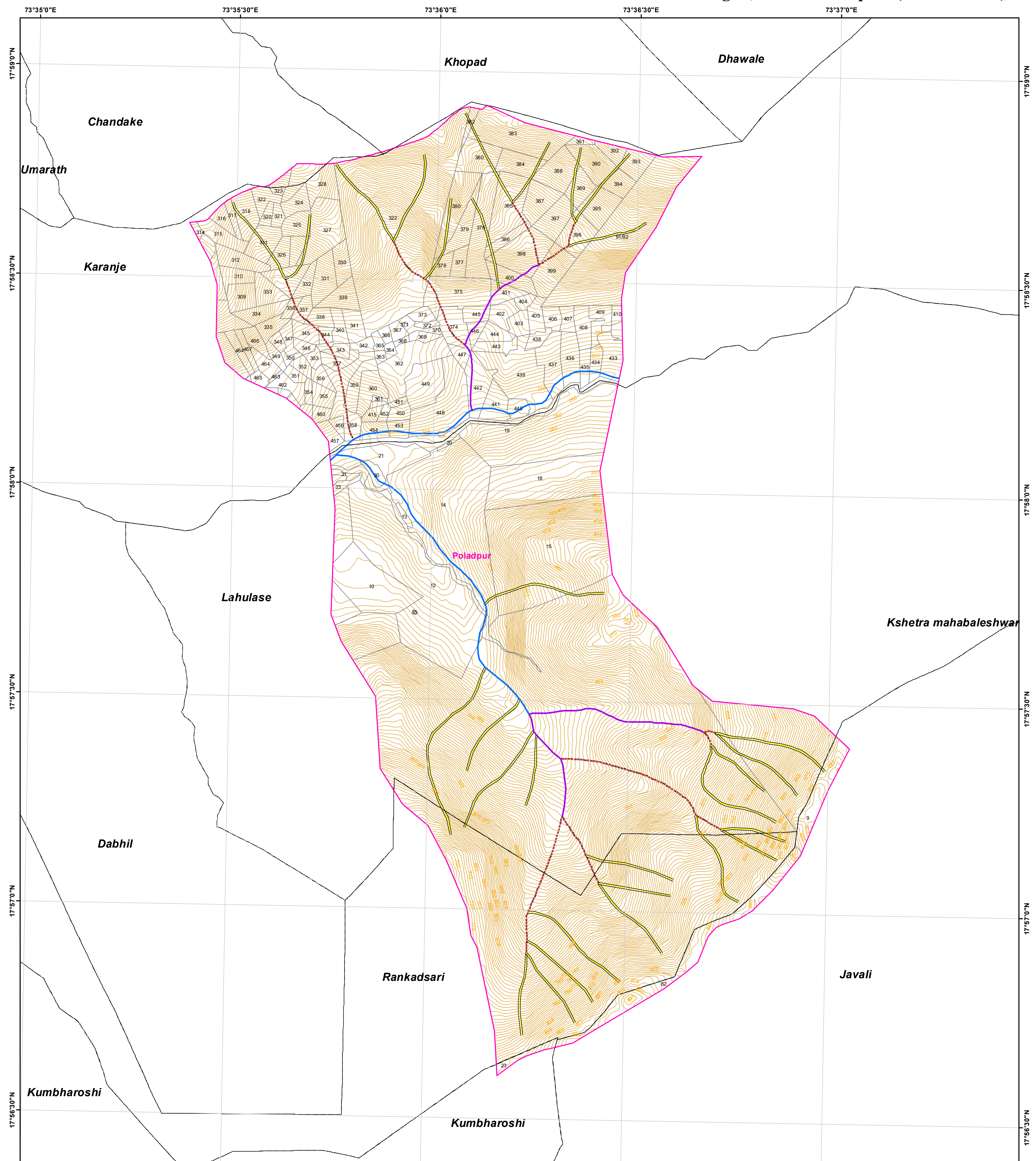

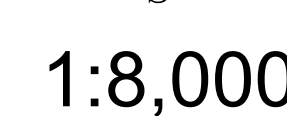


Drainage Line Treatment Zone
